What happens if I am accepted?

If you are accepted to attend, you will be contacted within two to three weeks of the completed application process and will be provided with additional information.

What is the cost to attend?

All Dream Street programs are free of charge.

Swimming, arts & crafts, horseback riding, archery, rock wall climbing, dancing, go carts, sports, ropes course and all kinds of special daily activities.
